

Visa Requirements

The information provided here is a guide to delegates based on data obtained from the Argentinean Department of Foreign Affairs in Buenos Aires. It is however subject to change and all delegates should make their own enquiries locally at the time of applying for a visa.

No Visa is required for citizens of the following countries to enter Argentina for business or as tourists for stay in Argentina for 90 days or less:

Visa or Travel Certificate is required for citizens of the following countries to enter Argentina for business or as tourists:

- (1) Tourist Visa, previous consult to corresponding security body.
- (2) Tourist: maximum of one (1) month stay.
- (3) With Travel Certificate, previous consult Consulate (decreo n° 7.488/61).
